

Iberia Soccer Association in conjunction with Louisiana Soccer Association and USYS have implemented new rules regarding <u>HEADING</u>. Concussions have become a big part of sports across the nation and the potential for concussions is greatest in athletic environments where collisions are common.

Coaches are now required to complete the CDC Heads-Up Concussion Course. This is a free course and only takes a few minutes to complete and parents are encouraged to take the course to learn the facts about concession and the signs to look for. Athletes playing in the U12 Division and under regardless of player's age shall not engage in heading, either in practices or in games. If a player, in the opinion of the referee, intentionally heads the ball a free kick will be awarded to the opposing team.

Athletes playing in the U13 Division and up shall be taught the importance of proper techniques for heading the ball both in practices and games.
